DIRECTIONS TO ROTHCO

3015 Veterans Memorial Highway (Route 454) Ronkonkoma, NY 11779

From the WEST

Via Northern State Parkway:

- o Go east on Northern State Parkway.
- o Northern State Parkway becomes Route 454 Veterans Memorial Highway.
- Go 7 miles on Route 454 Veterans Memorial Highway and make a U-turn at 5th Avenue to go east on Veterans Memorial Highway.
- o Go 0.3 miles and 3015 Veterans Memorial Highway is on the right.

Via The Long Island Expressway (I-495)

- o Take EXIT 57 toward RT-454/Commack/Patchogue.
- o Turn right onto Veterans Memorial Hwy/Veterans Hwy/RT-454 E.
- o Continue to follow Veterans Memorial Hwy/RT-454 E. for 3 miles and
- o Make a U-turn at 5th Avenue to go east on Veterans Memorial Highway.
- o Go 0.3 miles and 3015 Veterans Memorial Highway is on the right.

Via Sunrise Highway

- o Go east on Sunrise Highway to Lakeland Avenue in Bohemia
- o Go North on Lakeland Avenue for 2 miles
- o Turn left on Veterans Memorial Hwy/Veterans Hwy/RT-454 E.
- o Go 1.5 miles and 3015 Veterans Memorial Highway is on the right.

Via Southern State Parkway

- o Go east on Southern State Parkway
- o Southern State Parkway becomes Hecksher Parkway
- o Exit at Sunrise Highway to go east and continue as above Via Sunrise Highway

From the EAST

Via Sunrise Highway (Route 27)

- o Take Sunrise Highway (Route 27) West
- o Merge onto Veterans Memorial Hwy/RT-454 W toward Commack.
- o Go 4.8 miles and 3015 Veterans Memorial Highway is on the right.

Via The Long Island Expressway (I-495)

- o Take EXIT 59 toward Ocean Avenue.
- o Turn left onto Ocean Avenue for 1 mile
- o Bear Right onto Ocean Avenue at the fork. Continue for .7 mile.
- o Turn right onto Veterans Memorial Hwy/Veterans Hwy/RT-454 E.
- o Go 1.2 miles and it's the very large building on the right set back from the road.
- o Turn into the parking lot just before the building.
